

NEW HAMPSHIRE SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION

1 week sessions running from June - August
Monday - Friday 9:30 - 3:30

\$425.00 per week

SPACE LIMITED TO 10 STUDENTS PER WEEK

Each camper will receive a “Level Book” and all testing materials on the first day of camp. Every attempt will be made to place students in sessions with others in similar levels.

Every camper will be assigned a horse to be “their own” for the week. They will be responsible for the general care of their horse such as, grooming, tacking, bathing, watering, and preparing meals. (Stall cleaning is optional.)

A “demonstration” designed by the students showing what they learned during the week will be held for all parents and relatives on Friday afternoon. Following the performance there will be a graduation ceremony for those campers who were able to complete the requirements of their Level.

Children wishing to stay after camp hours must have Miss Sue’s permission and should be working on the “earn-a-ride” program or assisting with other lessons.

Recommendations of what to bring to camp everyday:

1. Level book
2. Pen or pencil
3. Lunch, drinks, snacks (A refrigerator and microwave is available for use). Cold sodas for sale for \$1.00.
4. Change of clothes, rain gear
5. Sunscreen

✍ **Proper footwear must be worn at all times. No open toed shoes!**

✍ **All riders must be outfitted with riding boots and riding helmets. (helmets provided and for sale).**

9:30 - 10:00	Arrival and camper “pow-wow” to discuss ideas for the day.
10:30 - 12: 30	Grooming, tacking, and preparing for morning ride
1:00 - 2:00	LUNCH and ARTS + CRAFTS
2:00 - 3:15	Afternoon ride (riding activity of campers’ choice - trail ride, bareback, games, etc.)
3:30	Pick-up
